You can choose from many different translations of the Bible. Choose a modern English translation like the New International Version. Summarize their message:

- Mt 24:35
- 2 Tm 3:15-16
- Jn 20:31
- Dt 4:2

Now type a word in the blank you'd like to explore, and take a look at some of the (many) passages that may appear. Try these for starters. Then think of some others you'd like to look up.
