Let us encourage one another -- and all the more as you see the Day approaching.

Sunday Morning Bible Class - Mysterious, visionary, and ultimately moving, the last book of the Bible gives Christians hope that the Lord of the church will rule and guide her to the end of time. After exploring in autumn 2019 the first half of Jesus' apocalypse, we will dig into the remaining chapters of the book of Revelation this spring.

Palm Sunday/Confirmation Services – The third examination of this year's confirmation class will be held on Saturday, March 27 at 6:30 pm. Pictures and confirmation rehearsal will take place immediately after the service. Our weekend service schedule will also be changed. Saturday worship will be at its regular time of 4:30 pm.
