Mask Update - As we venture post-Easter, post-mask mandate and beyond, we wish to continue to serve one another in a loving and considerate way. These three points summarize our leaders' views on this:

- Our weekly Saturday service at 4:30pm continues to be a mask-mandatory service, for the sake of those who are especially concerned about protecting their health.
- Our Sunday services are mask-optional services. Those choosing not to wear masks may want to sit closer to the front, to give mask-wearers the option to sit behind them.
- In all things, "Be devoted to one another in brotherly love" (Ro 12:10)--considering our gathering time a no-judgment zone as people make up their own minds as to how they might best serve the Lord and each other.

As always, your pastors and leaders invite your feedback as we seek to serve the flock of God with his Word and Sacrament.

Jesus Cares –Monday, May 9, the Jesus Cares program will be held in person in the fellowship hall of the south campus, beginning at 6:30 pm. Masks should be worn.

New for This Summer - Christ Alone will be hosting a Corn Hole League for the first time this summer. Currently we are planning for a league on Tuesday evenings, June 8-August 24 and
