**Tract Focus** - After Moses' death, Joshua led God's people into the Promised Land. In time, they were left without a single, central leader and repeatedly fell into idolatry with the false gods of neighboring nations, where "everyone did as they saw fit" (Judges 17:6). After periods of oppression, the Israelites cried out to God to save them, so in His time and love, God would raise up deliverers--called judges--to rescue His people.
