Philosophy

Goals

5. Students will engage in hands-on-activities which will lead to further scientific knowledge.

Objectives

Each classroom in PK-8th grade explore in various degrees life science, earth science, physical science, the human body, and health. The following listed items serve to highlight some of the specifics in each grade:

- a. PK – *classifying of objects, movement, sound, force*
- b. K – *senses, animals, insects, plants, weather*
- c. 1 – *senses, plants, seeds, habitats*
- d. 2 – *heat, light, sound, planets, magnets)*
- e. 3-4 – *life science, earth science, health, physical science*
- f. 5-6 – *life science, earth science, health, physical science*
- g. 7-8 – *earth science 1 year / life science 1 year*
